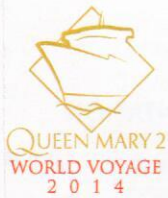

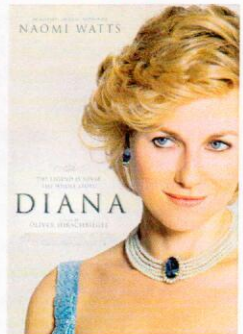

NAUTICAL FACT OF THE DAY THE NAUTICAL MILE

The nautical mile is the length of one minute (one sixtieth of one degree) of latitude, but the earth is not a perfect sphere – it is flattened at the Poles. This means that the length of 1 minute will be 6046 feet at the Equator and 6108 feet at the Poles, and so in conclusion a mean value of 6077 feet is actually used for the sea mile. The international nautical mile is a standard fixed length of 1852 meters.
